Meeting called to order.

The Pledge Allegiance was led by Mayor Scott Edwards.

Motion was made by Brian Ellis and seconded by Marshall Ginn to approve minutes of the October 4, 2010, regular session. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Don Chaney and seconded by Brian Ellis to approve paying the bills from the General Fund. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Marshall Ginn and seconded by Lana Call to approve paying the bills from the Coal Severance Fund. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Brian Ellis and seconded by Don Chaney to approve the General Fund Budget Revision and submit to the State Auditor's Office. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Brian Ellis and seconded by Don Chaney to have the second reading and adoption of an ORDINANCE 1300 PLANNING AND ZONING CODE ARTICLE 1358 PAWNBROKERS. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Marshall Ginn and seconded by Brian Ellis to have the second reading and adoption of an AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 936 STORMWATER MANAGEMENT, SURFACE WATER DISCHARGE AND EROSION CONTROL SECTION 936.22 PLAN SUBMISSION AND REVIEW PROCESS. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Don Chaney and seconded by Marshall Ginn to approve the COPS Grant Resolution. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Don Chaney and seconded by Lana Call to approve the EECBG Grant Resolution. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Don Chaney and seconded by Lana Call to accept the recommendation of the Municipal Planning Commission to not rezone 3422 Teays Valley Road to allow the sale of beer. 3 yeas Councilman Ellis opposed and Councilman Ginn abstained. The motion failed due to lack of quorum.

Motion was made by Don Chaney and seconded by Brian Ellis to approve the Christian Heritage Week Proclamation. Motion carried.

The Mayor read a letter of appreciation from a couple that needed assistance on the interstate and was appreciative of the police and fire departments.

Council discussed the issue of setting term limits for elected officials. The Secretary of State's office advised that would require an amendment to the City Charter. Council will discuss again at the December meeting.

Motion was made by Don Chaney and seconded by Brian to approve the purchase of a new police cruiser due to one being totaled when he by a deer. Motion carried.
