Motion was made by Don Chaney and seconded by Brian Ellis to approve minutes of the January 3, 2011, regular session. Motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning allowing ice fishing at the reservoir. After discussion it was decided by majority of council that is too dangerous and a liability to the city to allow.

**Hurricane Fire Department Report**

Deron Wilkes reported that the Fire Department answered 64 calls; 34 rescues and 30 EMS. Twelve people are taking the EMT training. Plans are to have a Community CPR Class soon.

**City Manager's Report**

Ben Newhouse, City Manager reported that Spring Clean-Up is April 2<sup>nd</sup> instead of May. They will take printers, TV;s and other electronics. A Water education day is planned for April 21.

**Police Chief's Report**

Mike Mullins reported that the department had 350 calls of not including traffic stops. Ice fishing on the reservoir has been a problem. Signs are up now and DNR officers are enforcing no ice fishing too.

**Old Business**

Councilwoman Call mentioned setting term limits. Councilman Chaney agreed. Majority of members say every four years the people have the opportunity to vote and that establishes term limits.
